




Everyday Madonna Exhibition - CPAC

JIM FLOOD. APRIL DEMO

Jim paints with a palette knife and gave us a demonstration on how he uses his knife to create his beautiful landscape paintings. He draws up his picture first using a cotton bud instead of a brush. He likes those which have a point at one end and are rounded at the other. Using a 'dirty brown' colour mixed with linseed oil and turps he proceeds to draw, taking his time to make sure the detail is right and he is happy. He then commenced by filling in the sky using a 'patting' motion like spreading butter, gradually going slightly darker as he moves up to the top and blending as he goes.

This gives a nice texture and natural look. Jim gave us many helpful tips and showed us several implements which he uses in his work. Many thanks Jim for a very informative morning. **Linda Ferlazzo**
