Artist in the Spotlight

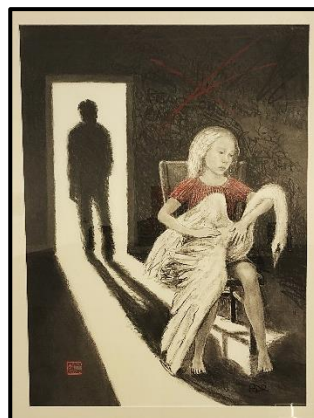
